Boundaries of Borough of Taradale and County of Hawke's Bay Redefined

PURSUANT to section 26 of the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, the Secretary for Internal Affairs hereby defines, as set out in the Schedule hereto, the boundaries of the Borough of Taradale and the County of Hawke's Bay, and the Meeanee Riding of the County of Hawke's Bay, the previous boundaries having been altered by Order in Council dated 15 February 1955, and published in Gazette, 17 February 1955, No. 12, page 247.
