RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

The Wellington City New Office Building Loan 1954, of £140,000

THE following resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Wellington City Council held on the 20th day of April 1955:

"In pursuance and in exercise of the powers and authorities vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926 and its amendments, the Wellington City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, repayment of principal, and other charges on a loan of one hundred and forty thousand pounds (£140,000) to be known as the Wellington City New Office Building Loan 1954, of £140,000, authorized to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of completing the Council's administrative building, the Wellington City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of seventy-nine eight-hundredths of a penny (79/800d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the whole of the City of Wellington; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten (10) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

The Wellington City Hutt Estuary Bridge Loan 1955, of £117,000

THE following resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Wellington City Council held on the 20th day of April 1955:

"In pursuance and in exercise of the powers and authorities vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926 and its amendments, the Wellington City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest, sinking fund, repayment of principal, and other charges on a loan of one hundred and seventeen thousand pounds (£117,000) to be known as the Wellington City Hutt Estuary Bridge Loan 1955, of £117,000, authorized to be raised by the Wellington City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of meeting the Council's share of the cost of constructing the Hutt Estuary Bridge and the cost of replacing and relocating water mains, the Wellington City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of fifty-three eight-hundredths of a penny (53/800d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the whole of the City of Wellington; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of April in each year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten (10) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
