## A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby alter the boundaries of the Poverty Bay Electric Power District so as to include therein the area described in the Schedule hereto, the said area being hitherto part of the Outer Area of the Bay of Plenty Electric Power District.

ALL that area in the Gisborne Land District being that portion of the Waikohu County described in the First Schedule to the Proclamation published in *New Zealand Gazette* No. 37 of the 31st day of May 1945, at page 602. As the said area is more particularly delineated on the plan marked S.H.D. 331 deposited in the office of the State Hydro-electric Department at Wellington, and thereon outlined in red.
