Plants Declared to be Noxious Weeds in the Borough of Rotorua (Notice No. Ag. 5891)

PURSUANT to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, the Director-General of Agriculture, acting under a delegation from the Minister of Agriculture for the purposes of the said Act, hereby publishes the following special order made by the Rotorua Borough Council on the 2nd day of May 1955. by the

SPECIAL ORDER

THAT in exercise of the authority vested in the Council by section 3 of the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, the Council of the Borough of Rotorua hereby resolves that the following weeds be declared noxious weeds for the purposes of the Noxious Weeds Act 1950:

Barberry (Berberis vulgaris).
Bindweed (Convolvulus arvensis).
Blackberry (Rubus fruticosus and Rubus laciniatus).
Californian thistle (Cirsium arvense).
Common broom (Cytisus scoparius).
Fennel (Foeniculum vulgare).
Gorse (Ulex, any species).
Hemlock (Conium maculatum).
Lupin (Lupinus aborcus).
Ragwort (Senecio jacobaea).
St. John's wort (Hypericum perforatum).
Saffron thistle (Carthamus lanatus).
Sweethrier (Rosa eglanteria syn. Rosa rubiginosa).
Water hyacinth (Eichhornia crassipes).
