## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

"That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on the repayment of a loan of £50,000, being the Waterworks Extension Loan 1954, the Te Awamutu Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one and two hundredths of a penny (1.02d.) in the pound upon the rateable unimproved value of all rateable property in the Borough of Te Awamutu; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND
