## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

*Makara County Staff Housing Loan 1955, £12,000*

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Makara County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £12,000 authorized to be raised by the Makara County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of purchasing land, erecting houses, and purchasing houses to accommodate Council employees, the said Makara County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of thirty-three hundredths pence (0.33d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in that portion of the Makara Riding of the County of Makara (as defined in *N.Z.
