Boundaries of Borough of Mount Wellington

All that area of approximately 4,075 acres in the North
Auckland Land District bounded by a line commencing at a
point on the line of mean high-water along the left bank of
the Tamaki River, in Block II, Otahuhu Survey District, being
the southernmost corner of Lot 985 on D.P. 39859, being part
of Allotment 39, District of Tamaki, and running southerly
generally along the line of mean high-water along that bank
of the totahuhu Creek to the northern side of Portage Road;
thence westerly along the northern side of that road, and
along a right line being the production of the western end of
that northern side across the North Island Main Trunk Railway to the line of mean high-water (spring tide) along the
shores of the Manukau Harbour; thence northerly along the
line of mean high-water (spring tide) along those shores, and
the left bank of St. Annes Creek, to the south-western side of

across the Auckland-Hamilton Motorway, to and along the
western boundary of the said part Lot 1, along a right line
across the Auckland-Hamilton Motorway, to and along the
south-western and north-western boundaries of Lot 6 on
D.P. 41128, a right line across favin Street ALL that area of approximately 4,075 acres in the North Auckland Land District bounded by a line commencing at a commencement.
