RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Pukekohe Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £11,000 authorized to be raised by the Pukekohe Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of acquiring, subdividing, and developing land for building allotments and constructing a street thereon, the said Pukekohe Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of thirty-two one hundredths of a penny (32/100d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property of the whole of the Borough of Pukekohe; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of August in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of five (5) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

ALL that area situated partly within the City of New Plymouth and partly within the Taranaki County and bounded as follows: Commencing at a point on the Tasman Sea at the mouth of the Waiongona Stream; thence generally southerly up the Waiongona Stream and the Mangaoraka Stream to the southern boundary of the Taranaki County; thence generally westerly, northerly, and southerly along the boundary of the Taranaki County as described in *N.Z.
