## RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

*Workers' Dwellings Loan 1955, £18,000*

IN pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, and all other powers thereto enabling, the Horowhenua County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of principal, interest, and other charges on a loan of eighteen thousand pounds (£18,000) authorized to be raised by the Horowhenua County Council for the purpose of purchasing or erecting workers' dwellings, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three sixty-fourths of a penny ( $\frac{3}{64}$ d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the County of Horowhenua; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and payable half-yearly on the 1st day of September and the 1st day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years (25), or until the loan is fully paid off."
