THE following decisions in interpretation of the Sales Tax Act 1932-33 are published for public information:

PART I—GOODS INCLUDED IN STATUTORY EXEMPTIONS FROM SALES TAX

Bicycles, etc.	Handlebar grips not less than 1 in. in internal diameter.
Brushware, all kinds, etc.	Boxed or cased sets . . . other articles.
Rubber (including sponge rubber) in sheets	Rubber in strips, even with a backing of textile or other material.
