RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Cambridge Road Water Supply Special Area Loan 1955, £7,800

N pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Waipa County Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, principal, and other charges on a special loan of £7,800 authorized to be raised by the Waipa County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of providing a water supply in the Cambridge Road Water Supply Special Rating Area, the Waipa County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three and one-half pence (3½d.) in the pound upon the unimproved rateable value of all rateable property of the said Cambridge Road Water Supply Special Rating Area described in the Schedule hereto, and that such rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable yearly on the 1st day of September in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years, or until the loan is fully paid off.

S. 1450; thence north-east along the north-west boundary of the said Lot 13 to its north-west boundary of Lot 13 to its intersection with the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. S. 2255; thence in a northerly direction along the western boundaries of Lots 1, 2, 3, D.P. S. 2255, to the north-west corner of Lot 3, D.P.
