

## SCHEDULE

ALL that area in the Marlborough and Nelson Land Districts, bounded by a line commencing at a point on mean high-water mark in Cloudy Bay at the northernmost corner of Section 163, Wakefield Downs Registration District, Block III, Clifford Bay Survey District; thence proceeding southerly generally by the north-eastern boundary of Section 163 to the north-eastern corner of the said Section 163; thence westerly generally by a right line to the south-western corner of Section 158, Wakefield Downs Registration District; thence continuing south-westerly generally by a right line to the south-eastern corner of Section 8, Block 2, Wairau Registration District; thence south-westerly generally by a right line to where the road crosses the railway in Section 2 of Block I, Awatere Registration District; thence westerly generally by a right line to where the southern boundary of Section 27 of Block 2, Awatere Registration District, meets Boundary Stream; thence north-westerly generally by Boundary Stream, being also the boundary of the Marlborough County, to Maxwell Pass at the south-eastern corner of Section 37 of Square 39, Awatere Registration District; thence south-westerly generally by the south-eastern boundaries of Section 37 of Square 39, Awatere Registration District, Section 79, and the south-eastern boundary of Section 83, Dumgree Run, Awatere Registration District, to its junction with Section 2, Block XIV, Taylor Pass Survey District; thence continuing in a south-westerly direction generally by a right line to the most eastern corner of Section 38 of Square 39, Awatere Registration District; thence by the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 38 and 39 of Square 39, Awatere Registration District, the south-eastern and south-western boundaries of Section 40 of Square 39, Awatere Registration District, to the Marlborough County Boundary; thence south-westerly generally by the Marlborough County Boundary to the southernmost point of Run 107 in Block I, Upcot Survey District; thence northerly, westerly, and south-westerly generally by the southern boundaries of Run 107, and State forest to the Marlborough Nelson Land District Boundary; thence south-westerly generally by the Land District Boundary, aforesaid, to the south-westernmost point in Block VII, Wairau Survey District; thence south-westerly generally by a right line to Trig. Station FR in Block XII, Rainbow Survey District; thence south-westerly generally by a ridge to Mount Balaklava in Block II, Alma Survey District; thence westerly and northerly generally by the summit of the range around the water-shed of the Wairau and Rainbow Rivers, through Crystal Peak, Mount Guinevere, Mount Dora, to the Amuri County Boundary at Topo Station Z, thence north-easterly generally by the boundary of the Amuri County to the south-western corner of Section 11, Block XIV, Motupiko Survey District; thence northerly and easterly generally by the western and northern boundaries of Sections 11, 1, 2, and Part 4, to the Marlborough County Boundary; thence north-easterly generally by the Marlborough County Boundary to a point due south from Trig. Station Red Hill; thence by a right line due north to Trig. Station Red Hill; thence north-easterly generally by the summit of the Richmond Range to the Marlborough County Boundary at Wards Pass; thence continuing north-easterly generally by the Marlborough County Boundary to Slate Peak; thence north-westerly generally by a right line to Mount Starveall on the Bryant Range; thence north-easterly generally by the summit of the Bryant Range, through Mount Gale, Trig. LA, Trig. Rocks, Mangatapu, to the Marlborough County Boundary at Trig. Station, Saddle Hill; thence continuing north-easterly generally by the Marlborough County Boundary to Trig. Station, McLarens Peak; thence continuing in a southerly direction generally by the Marlborough County Boundary to Opouri Peak; thence south-westerly, southerly, and south-easterly generally by the summit of the range between the water-sheds of the Opouri River and Kaiuma Stream to its junction with the boundary between Blocks III and VII, Wakamarina Survey District; thence south-easterly generally by a right line to the northernmost corner of part Section 1 of 1, Block VII, Wakamarina Survey District; thence continuing southerly generally by the north-eastern and eastern boundaries of part Section 1 of 1, 6, 49, 50, and 14, Block VIII, Wakamarina Survey District, to mean high-water mark in Havelock Harbour, Pelorus Sound; thence westerly and southerly generally by high-water mark to and across the Pelorus River, and continuing easterly and southerly generally by high-water mark to and across the Kaituna River; thence northerly generally by high-water mark to its junction with the Picton-Havelock Main Highway; thence by a right line approximately due east to the north-eastern corner of Section 46, Mahakipawa Registration District; thence south-easterly generally by the eastern boundaries of Sections 2 and 3A to the south-eastern corner of the said Section 3A, Block XII, Wakamarina Survey District; thence south-easterly generally by a right line to the north-eastern corner of Section 2, Block XIII, Linkwater Survey District; thence easterly generally by a right line to Trig. Station, Mount Cullen; thence easterly generally by a right line to the north-western corner of Section 3, Block XIII, Linkwater Survey District, and continuing easterly generally by the northern boundary of Section 3, to Trig. Station LL, height 3,109 ft.; thence north-easterly generally by the summit of the range at the head of the water-shed of Dry and Speeds Creeks to Trig. Station Z, height 2,384 ft.; thence north-easterly generally by a right line to the westernmost corner of Section 10, Block XI, Linkwater Survey District; thence north-easterly generally by the northern boundary of Section 10 to the north-western corner of Section 1, Block XI, Linkwater Survey District; thence south-easterly generally

by the north-eastern boundary of Section 1 to the north-western corner of Section 6, Block XI, Linkwater Survey District; thence south-easterly generally by a right line to Trig. Station A, height 1,243 ft., being on the eastern boundary of Section 22, Block XII, Linkwater Survey District; thence southerly and easterly generally by the eastern boundaries of Sections 22, 3, 4, Run 65, and Section 6 to its easternmost point; thence southerly generally by a right line to Trig. Station, Mount Robertson, height 3,397 ft.; thence southerly generally by a right line to the easternmost corner of Section 8, Block IV, Cloudy Bay Survey District; thence continuing southerly generally by a right line to Sub. Trig. Station IX, height 1,767 ft.; thence southerly generally by a right line to Sub. Trig. Station 41, height 1,189 ft.; thence southerly generally by a right line to the north-western corner of the Wairau Harbour Board Endowment in Block IV, Cloudy Bay Survey District; thence easterly generally by the northern boundary of the Wairau Harbour Board Endowment to mean high-water mark in Cloudy Bay; thence southerly generally by mean high-water mark to and across the Wairau River, and still continuing by mean high-water mark to the point of commencement.

**P**URSUANT to the Soil Conservation and Rivers Control Act 1941, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby declares (a) that the Marlborough Catchment Board shall consist of seven elective members and six non-elective members, and (b) that the number of such elective members to be representative of each separate constituent district or combined district within the catchment district on the said Board shall be the number specified in the Schedule hereto opposite the name of that constituent district or group of names of constituent districts comprising a combined district, and (c) that the group of constituent districts the names of which are bracketed together in the first column of the Schedule hereto is hereby constituted a combined district for the purposes of the said Act, and (d) that the County of Marlborough shall be the principal local authority of the combined district.
