

Reciprocal Enforcement of Maintenance Orders in the Falkland Islands

IT is notified for general information that maintenance orders made in New Zealand may now be enforced in the Falkland Islands. A Proclamation of the Governor of the Falkland Islands dated 7 April 1954 extended the Maintenance Orders (Facilities for Enforcement) Ordinance of 27 September 1921 to maintenance orders made by Courts in New Zealand.

Retail Sale and Distribution of Motor Spirit

A. F. Helleur, Main North Road, Wellsford, has applied for a licence to resell motor spirit from one pump to be installed on service-station and garage premises at Main North Road, Wellsford.

- That the return to shareholders shall be by means of dividends on reduced working expenses.
