PURSUANT to the Education Act 1914, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Morrinsville College Board of Governors Order 1955.

2. The constitution of the Board of Governors for Morrinsville College prescribed by section 90 of the Education Act 1914 is hereby varied so that the school shall be controlled by a Board of Governors constituted as follows:

- (a) One member appointed by the South Auckland Education Board;
- (b) Four members elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school;
- (c) One member appointed by the Governor-General;
- (d) One member appointed by the Morrinsville Borough Council;
- (e) One member appointed by the Piako County Council;
- (f) One member appointed by the Board of Governors itself.
