RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Fire Prevention Plant Loan 1954, £2,000

THE following resolution making a special rate was passed at a meeting of the Council held on the 13th day of September 1955:

"That, in pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Richmond Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

" 'That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of two thousand pounds (£2,000) authorized to be raised by the Richmond Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of purchasing a fire engine and plant, the said Richmond Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one-sixteenth of a penny ($\frac{1}{16}$ d.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property of the Borough of Richmond; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable on the 1st day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten years, or until the loan is fully paid off.' "
