Barberry (Berberis vulgaris). Bathurst bur (Xanthium spinosum). Blackberry (Rubus fruticosus and Rubus laciniatus). Gorse (Ulex, any species). Hemlock (Conium maculatum). Milk thistle or variegated thistle (Silybum marianum). Ragwort (Senecio jacobaea). Sweetbrier (Rosa eglantaria syn. Rosa rubiginosa). Montpelier broom (Cytisus monspessulanus). Wild teasel (Dipsacus silvester). Common broom (Cytisus scoparius).
