RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

CERTIFIED copy of a resolution passed at a meeting of the Auckland City Council held on the 13th day of October 1955:

“In pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Municipal Corporations Act 1954, the local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Local Bodies' Loans Amendment Act 1951, the Local Government Loans Board Act 1926, and regulations thereunder, and of all other powers thereunto enabling it, the Auckland City Council hereby resolves as follows:

“That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on a loan of thirty-three thousand four hundred pounds (£33,400) to be known as the Motor Vehicle Testing Station Additional Loan 1955, £33,400, which amount is proposed to be raised by the Auckland City Council under the above-mentioned Acts for the purpose of erecting a motor vehicle testing station on the Great North Road for the City of Auckland, and the cost of raising the loan, the said Auckland City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of two-twenty-sevenths of one penny (2/27d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the annual value) of all rateable property in the City of Auckland; and that the said special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan and shall be payable yearly on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of the said loan or until the loan is fully paid off.”
