Plants Declared Noxious Weeds in the Town District of Hikurangi (Notice No. Ag. 5986)

PURSUANT to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, and acting under a delegation from the Minister of Agriculture for the purposes of the said Act, the Acting Director-General of Agriculture hereby publishes the following Special Order made by the Hikurangi Town Council on the 20th day of September 1955.

SPECIAL ORDER

THAT in pursuance and in exercise of the powers vested in it under the Municipal Corporations' Act 1954, the Hikurangi Town Council declares by way of Special Order that each and all of the plants mentioned in the Schedule hereunder are noxious weeds within the meaning of the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, within the boundaries of the Hikurangi Town District:

- Blackberry (*Rubus fruticosus* and *Rubus laciniatus*).
- Californian thistle, Canadian thistle, or creeping thistle (*Cirsium arvense*).
- Gorse (*Ulex*, any species).
- Hemlock (*Conium maculatum*).
- Nodding thistle (*Carduus nutans*).
- Ragwort (*Senecio jacobaea*).
- Winged thistle (*Carduus tenuiflorus* and *Carduus pycnocephalus*).
