

BANKS PENINSULA ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926 and amendments, and all other powers it thereunto enabling, the Banks Peninsula Electric Power Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, principal, and other charges on the Kinloch Reticulation Loan 1955, £13,300, authorized to be raised by the Banks Peninsula Electric Power Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of further reticulating the Board's District, the said Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of one twenty-sixth of a penny ($\frac{1}{26d.}$) in the pound (£1) on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Banks Peninsula Electric Power District; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable annually on the 1st day of June in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
