## Plants Declared Noxious Weeds in the County of Franklin (Notice No. Ag. 5996)

PURSUANT to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, and acting under delegation from the Minister of Agriculture for the purposes of the said Act, the Acting Director-General of Agriculture hereby publishes the following Special Order made by the Franklin County Council on the 31st day of October 1955.

## SPECIAL ORDER

“THAT in exercise of the powers conferred on it by the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, the Franklin County Council hereby resolves and declares, by way of Special Order, that Bathurst bur (*Xanthium spinosum*) and Thorn apple or jimson weed (*Datura stramonium*), being plants mentioned in the First Schedule of the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, to be noxious weeds within the County of Franklin.”
