

Road Closed by Order of the Maori Land Court

PURSUANT to section 489 of the Maori Land Act 1931, the Maori Land Court made an Order dated 6 August 1953 declaring the piece of road described in the Schedule hereto to be a closed road and vesting it in the owners of the Kaitara No. 2A 1A Block.
