PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby licenses and permits Horace Tomkies, of Queenstown (hereinafter called the licensee, which term shall include his executors, administrators, or assigns, unless the context requires a different construction), to use and occupy a part of the bed of the lake at Queenstown Bay, Lake Wakatipu, as shown on plan marked M.D. 7661, and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington, for the purpose of erecting and maintaining a jetty as shown on the said plan as marked on the said plan as "Kelvin", such licence to be held and enjoyed by the licensee upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

1. This licence is subject to the Foreshore Licence Regulations 1940, and the provisions of those regulations shall, so far as applicable, apply hereto.
2. The premium payable by the licensee shall be two pounds (£2) and the annual sum so payable shall be five pounds (£5).
3. The term of the licence shall be 14 years from the 1st day of November 1955.
