

Price Order No. 1594 (Amendment No. 1 of Price Order No. 1566) (Footwear)

PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act 1947, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following amending Price Order:

1. This Order may be cited as Price Order No. 1594, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 1566* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. This Order shall come into force on the 11th day of February 1955.

3. The First Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by inserting in the said Schedule under the heading of Men's Footwear the item in the Schedule hereto:

SCHEDULE

Kind of Goods	Maximum Percentage
Men's shoes or sandals with canvas or similar uppers and rubber or rubber composition soles of a type suitable for casual or promenade wear, but not including laced sand shoes or tennis shoes	35

Plants Declared Noxious Weeds in the Borough of Woodville (Notice No. Ag. 5833)

PURSUANT to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, the Director-General of Agriculture, acting under a delegation from the Minister of Agriculture for the purpose of the said Act, hereby publishes the following special order made by the Woodville Borough Council on the 25th day of January 1955.

SPECIAL ORDER

THAT the Woodville Borough Council, pursuant to the provisions of the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, doth hereby resolve by way of special order that the plants mentioned in the Schedule hereunder be and are hereby declared to be noxious weeds within the Borough of Woodville.

SCHEDULE

Bindweed (*Convolvulus arvensis*).
Blackberry (*Rubus fruticosus* and *Rubus laciniatus*).
Boxthorn (*Lycium ferocissimum* syn. *Lycium horridum*).
Californian thistle, Canadian thistle, or creeping thistle (*Cirsium arvense*).
Common broom (*Cytisus scoparius*).
Fennel (*Foeniculum vulgare*).
Foxglove (*Digitalis purpurea*).
Goat's rue (*Galega officinalis*).
Gorse (*Ulex*, any species).
Grey willow (*Salix cinerea*).
Hawthorn (*Crataegus oxyacantha* and *Crataegus monogyna*).
Hemlock (*Conium maculatum*).
Milk thistle or variegated thistle (*Silybum marianum*).
Pussy willow (*Salix discolor*).
Ragwort (*Senecio jacobaea*).
Saffron thistle or plume thistle (*Cirsium lanceolatum*).
Silver poplar (*Populus alba* var. *nivea*).
Star thistle (*Centaurea calcitrapa*).
Sweetbrier (*Rosa eglanteria* syn. *Rosa rubiginosa*).
Wild turnip (*Brassica campestris*).
Winged thistle (*Carduus tenuiflorus* and *Carduus pycnocephalus*).
Yellow star thistle (*Centaurea solstitialis*).
