"That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of interest, principal, and other charges on the Taranaki County Workers' Dwellings Loan 1955, of £6,000, authorised to be raised by the Taranaki County Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of erecting workers' dwellings, the said Taranaki County Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of 0.038 pence in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the whole of the County of Taranaki; and that such special rate shall be a recurring special rate during the currency of the said loan, and be payable yearly on the 4th day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

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HUTT VALLEY ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION LEVYING RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Hutt Valley Electric Power Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a special loan of £50,000, authorised to be raised by the Hutt Valley Electric Power Board under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of providing for staff housing, such loan to be known as Staff Housing Loan 1955, the said Hutt Valley Electric Power Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of eleven two-hundredths of a penny ($\frac{11}{200}$.) in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the Hutt Valley Electric Power District; and that such special rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 31st day of March in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five (25) years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
