Proclaiming a Tribal District Under the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act 1945

C. W. M. NORRIE, Governor-General [L.S.] A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 6 of the Maori Social and Economic **P**URSUANT to section 6 of the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act 1945, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, do hereby declare the parts of New Zealand described in the Schedule hereto to be a tribal district for the purposes of the said Act, and do hereby assign to the said district the name Puaha-o-Waikato Tribal District.

SCHEDULE

PUAHA-O-WAIKATO TRIBAL DISTRICT

PUAHA-O-WAIKATO IRIBAL DISTRICT ALL that area in the Raglan and Franklin Counties bounded by a line commencing at the eastern corner of the Franklin Tribal District, being the easternmost corner of Allotment 53, Mangatawhiri Parish, in Block IX, Opaheke Survey District, and running southerly along a right line to Trig. Station No. 98 in Block V, Maramarua Survey District, along another right line to Trig. Station No. 72 in Block IV, Awaroa Sur-vey District; thence westerly along a right line to the mouth of the Ohuka Stream in Block III, Coast Survey District; thence northerly along the shores of the Tasman Sea to and easterly generally along the southern boundary of the Frank-lin Tribal District as hereinbefore described, to the point of commencement. commencement.

A PROCLAMATION **PURSUANT** to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby taken for street, and shall vest in the Mayor, Coun-cillors, and Citizens of the Borough of Te Aroha as from the date hereinafter mentioned; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 19th day of March 1956.
