RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Staff Housing Loan 1955, £1,900

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Government Loans Act 1926, the Kaiapoi Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £1,900 authorised to be raised by the Kaiapoi Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act, for providing a Staff Housing Loan 1955, the said Kaiapoi Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of two hundred and twenty-one thousandths of a penny (221/1000d.) in the pound of unimproved value on all ratable property of the Borough of Kaiapoi; and that such special rate shall be an annual and recurring rate during the currency of the loan and be payable half-yearly on the 27th day of September and 27th day of March, in each and every year during the currency of the loan, being a period of twenty years, until the loan is fully paid off."
