A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Proclamation dated the 7th day of July 1952 and published in the *Gazette* of that year at page 1175, and deposited in the Land Registry Office at Auckland as No. 13576, in so far as it affects Lots 2 and 3, D.P. 37335, being portion of Allotments 6 and 8, Section 16, Town of Onehunga, and being all the land comprised and described in certificate of title, Volume 1111, folio 25, Auckland Registry; also part Lot 2, D.P. 21247, being portion of Allotments 4 and 6, Section 16, Town of Onehunga, containing 36.2 perches, and being the balance of the land comprised in certificate of title, Volume 1016, folio 228, Auckland Registry.

PURSUANT to the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby licenses and permits Hubert Victor Albertson (hereinafter called the licensee, which term shall include his executors, administrators, or assigns, unless the context requires a different construction) to use and occupy a part of the foreshore and land below low-water mark at Half-moon Bay, Stewart Island, as shown on approved plan marked M.D. 6423 and deposited in the office of the Marine Department at Wellington, for the purpose of maintaining thereon a stacking stage as shown on the said plan, such licence to be held and enjoyed by the licensee upon and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

1. This licence is subject to the Foreshore Licence Regulations 1940, and the provisions of those regulations shall, so far as applicable, apply hereto.

2. The premium payable by the licensee shall be two pounds (£2) and the annual sum so payable six pounds (£6).

3. The term of the licence shall be fourteen years from the 1st day of February 1956.
