393 (1)	Metal .. .. Brushing emery compo. (See decision Tariff item 392 (2).)
448 (3)	Filters .. .. Delete the word "brass" from the decision reading "Nozzles, brass filter, for Candy filters."
448 (3)	.. .. Vitamins A, B <sub>2</sub> , and D <sub>3</sub> , synthetic, declared by a manufacturer . . . mixing with poultry foods.

## AMENDMENT

The decision under Tariff item 352 (b) in Part V of Tariff Order 169 which reads "Pans, tanks, vats, kettles, and other vessels, of metal (other than cast-iron lined with acid resisting material), with or without agitators and whether or not heated by any means" should have been shown as follows—
