HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 193 (4) of the Counties Act 1920, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby prescribes a scale of principal and interest payments for loans repayable over a period of twenty-five years with interest at the rate of 4½ per cent per annum.

SCALE

AMOUNT OF PRINCIPAL AND INTEREST PAYABLE DURING EACH PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS FOR EVERY £100 OF UNPAID PURCHASE MONEY OR ADVANCE AT 4½ PER CENT INTEREST FOR A PERIOD OF TWENTY-FIVE YEARS
