A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Wildlife Act 1953, I, Major-General the Right Honourable Sir Harold Eric Barrowclough, the Administrator of the Government of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare the area described in the Schedule hereto to be a Wildlife Refuge for the purposes of the said Act.

SCHEDULE

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District being portion of the Porirua Harbour bounded by a line commencing at a point on the shore of Porirua Harbour in line with the south-western boundary of Section 84, Porirua District, situated in Block VIII, Paekakariki Survey District, and proceeding south-easterly and southerly generally along the shore across the mouth of the Pauatahanui River, westerly and northerly generally again along the shore, and a public road to the headland at the north-eastern corner of Section 93, Porirua District; thence north-westerly along a right line across Porirua Harbour to a point on the shore in line with the south-western boundary of Section 84, Porirua District, being the point of commencement; as the same is more particularly delineated on plan marked I.A. 46/137 deposited in the Head Office, Department of Internal Affairs, Wellington, and thereon edged red.
