"(1) That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of principal, interest, and other charges on the first part of the Housing Loan 1955, being the Community Housing Loan of eight thousand pounds (£8,000) authorised to be raised by the Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of purchasing land and erecting dwellings for rental or sale, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one hundred and thirty-two thousandths of one penny (0.132d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of unimproved value) of all rateable property in the County of Awatere, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable on the 12th day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty-five years until the loan is fully paid off.

"(2) That, for the purpose of providing for the payment of principal, interest, and other charges on the second part of the Housing Loan 1955, being the Staff Housing Loan of eight thousand pounds (£8,000) authorised to be raised by the Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of purchasing land and erecting dwellings for rental or sale, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of one hundred and forty-nine one-thousandths of one penny (0.149d.) in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property in the County of Awatere, and that such special rate shall be annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable annually on the 12th day of April in each and every year during the currency of such loan being a period of twenty-five years until the loan is fully paid off."
