Varying a Notice Declaring Parts of a Tribal District to be a Tribal Committee Area Under the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act 1945

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Maori Social and Economic Advancement Act 1945, the Minister of Maori Affairs hereby varies a notice dated 16 December 1947 and published in the *Gazette* on 8 January 1948, at page 20, declaring parts of the Tuwharetoa No. 1 Tribal District to be Tribal Committee areas for the purpose of the said Act by excluding from the Schedule thereto the descriptions of the Mangakoura and Rotongaio-Waitahanui Tribal Committee areas, and substituting therefor the description appearing in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE

"WAITAHANUI TRIBAL COMMITTEE AREA

"ALL that area bounded by a line commencing at Rangatira Point on the shore of Lake Taupo in Block V, Tauhara Survey District; thence proceeding easterly generally along a straight line to the westernmost corner of Tauhara Middle No. 4A 1R Block in Block VI, Tauhara Survey District, a straight line to the southernmost corner of Lot 9 on Deposited Plan No. 21389 in Block VI, Heruiwi Survey District, and a straight line passing through Trig. Station 4 in Block VII, Heruiwi Survey District, to its intersection with a straight line between Trig. Station F (Tiritiri) in Block III, Heruiwi Survey District, and Trig. Station B (Pukeroa) in Block XI, Heruiwi Survey District; thence southerly along the last-mentioned straight line to Trig. Station B aforesaid; thence easterly generally along a straight line to Trig. Station Te Taumutu and a straight line to the point of intersection of straight lines from Trig. Stations Tawhiuau and 69 (Tatarookino) and from the northern point of Lake Waikaremoana, passing through a point 180 chains due north of Trig. Station Maungataniwha; thence south-easterly from the said point of intersection along a straight line to a point in the middle of the Te Hoe River in line with the south-western boundary of Heruiwi No. 4 Block; thence down the middle of that river to a point in line with the northern boundary of Tatarookino
