RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

Westshore Streets Loan 1954, of £89,300 (£10,000 Portion)

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Napier City Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on a loan of £10,000 (ten thousand pounds) authorised to be raised by the Napier City Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of reconstructing and sealing streets and footpaths at Westshore and providing kerbing and channelling and stormwater drainage, the said Napier City Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of .005 (decimal nought nought five) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all rateable property within the City of Napier; and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan and be payable on the 17th day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of five years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

*Tautau Water Supply Development Loan 1954 (£220,000),
Third Issue £55,000*

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Mount Maunganui Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing the interest and other charges on the loan of £55,000 authorised to be raised by the Mount Maunganui Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of providing a supply of water to the Borough of Mount Maunganui and for the provision of land, easements, plant, and buildings ancillary to the establishment of such supply, the said Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of thirty-five sixths pence (35/64d.) in the pound (£) upon the rateable value (on the basis of the unimproved value) of all the rateable property in the Borough of Mount Maunganui; and such special rate shall be an annually recurring special rate during the currency of the loan and be payable yearly on the first day of July in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of ten years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

The foregoing resolution was duly passed at a meeting of the Mount Maunganui Borough Council held on the 9th day of July 1956.
