A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that easements for an electric-power substation are hereby taken over the land described in the First Schedule hereto, vesting in the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the Borough of Riccarton (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") as from the date hereinafter mentioned, the full and free liberty, right, licence, and authority in perpetuity to lay, construct, place, and maintain a line of underground cables of any size or nature whatsoever and to lay, construct, put up, and place overhead electric lines and poles in, under, along, and over the land described in the said First Schedule, and to convey electricity through the said cables and electric lines together with the further right for the Corporation, its servants, agents, and workmen to enter upon the said land from time to time, by day and by night, with trucks, motor vehicles, and machinery of all description, laden or unladen, for the purposes of opening up the soil and inspecting, repairing, renewing, maintaining, operating, and testing the said underground cables and overhead electric lines and poles and all other electrical equipment whatsoever, and also with all other materials, plant, and equipment necessary to repair, rebuild, renew, alter, or extend the electric-power substation of the said Corporation, such easements to be held appurtenant to the land described in the Second Schedule; and I also hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the said Second Schedule hereto is hereby taken for an electric-power substation and shall vest in the Mayor, Councillors, and Citizens of the Borough of Riccarton as from the date hereinafter mentioned; and I further declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 6th day of August 1956.
