RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, the Motueka Borough Council hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing interest and other charges on a loan of £7,500 authorised to be raised by the Motueka Borough Council under the above-mentioned Act for the purpose of street development, the said Motueka Borough Council hereby makes and levies a special rate of three thirty-seconds of a penny in the pound on the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property in the Borough of Motueka, and that such special rate shall be an annually recurring rate during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years, or until the loan is fully paid off."
