Plant Declared a Noxious Weed in Stratford County (Notice No. Ag. 6150)

PURSUANT to the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, the Director-General of Agriculture, acting under a delegation from the Minister of Agriculture for the purposes of the said Act, hereby publishes the following special order made by the Stratford County Council on the 17th day of August 1956.

# SPECIAL ORDER

That, pursuant to the provisions of section 3 (1) of the Noxious Weeds Act 1950, the Stratford County Council resolves, by way of special order, that the noxious weed Water Hyacinth (*Eichhornia crassipes*) shall be deemed to be a noxious weed within the whole County of Stratford.
