4. The local authority of the constituent district distinguished in the first column of the Schedule hereto by the letter "(P)" shall be the principal local authority of the combined district of which it forms a part.

5. The Order in Council dated the 12th day of April 1938 and published in the Gazette on the 13th day of the same month, at page 933, reapportioning representation on the Te Awamutu Electric Power Board, is hereby revoked.
