ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Putaruru High School Board of Governors Order 1956.

2. The constitution of the Board of Governors for Putaruru High School prescribed by section 90 of the Education Act 1914 is hereby varied so that the school shall be controlled by a Board of Governors constituted as follows:

- (a) One member appointed by the South Auckland Education Board;
- (b) Five members elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school;
- (c) One member appointed by the Governor-General;
- (d) One member appointed by the Putaruru Borough Council;
- (e) One member appointed by the Matamata County Council;
- (f) One member to be co-opted by the Board of Governors itself, if and when it thinks fit.

1. This order may be cited as the Huntly College Board of Governors Order 1956.

2. The constitution of the Board of Governors for Huntly College prescribed by section 90 of the Education Act 1914 is hereby varied so that the school shall be controlled by a Board of Governors constituted as follows:

- (a) One member appointed by the South Auckland Education Board;
- (b) Six members elected by the parents of the pupils attending the school;
- (c) One member appointed by the Governor-General;
- (d) One member appointed by the Huntly Borough Council.

*Reapportioning Representation on the Waitemata Electric Power Board*

THE RIGHT HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby determines as follows:

1. This Order in Council shall come into force on the date of the next general election of members of local authorities (hereinafter referred to as "the specified date").

2. The number of representatives of each constituent district of the Waitemata Electric Power District on the Waitemata Electric Power Board shall be the number specified in the Schedule hereto opposite the name of that constituent district.

3. The constituent districts which are bracketed together in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be combined districts for the purposes of the said Act.

4. The local authority of each constituent district distinguished in the first column of the Schedule hereto by the letter "(P)" shall be the principal local authority of the combined district of which it forms a part.

5. The first elections of the representative of the constituent district of the East Coast Bays Borough and of the representatives of the combined districts of (a) Waitemata County and Helensville Borough, (b) Rodney County and Warkworth Town District, and (c) Glen Eden and Henderson Boroughs, shall be held on the specified date.

6. The Order in Council dated the 12th day of April 1944 and published in the *Gazette* on the 13th day of the same month, at page 359, reapportioning representation on the Waitemata Electric Power Board, is hereby revoked.

7. The Order in Council dated the 1st day of July 1953 and published in the *Gazette* on the 2nd day of the same month, at page 1004, amending the said Order in Council dated the 12th day of April 1944, is hereby revoked.
