PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby revoke the Proclamation dated the 2nd day of February 1955 and published in *Gazette*, 10 February 1955, Volume I, page 204, and deposited in the Land Registry Office at Christchurch as No. 413042, taking land for State housing purposes in the City of Christchurch, in so far as it affects the land described in the Schedule hereto.
