## 51. Left Parcels

## Paragraphs 1 and 2: Omit these paragraphs and substitute:

1. Left-parcel labels, in books of twenty, may be obtained at principal stations, at a charge of 10s. per book.
2. The charge for left parcels covers one week's storage. After the first week, storage will be charged for the ensuing three weeks at the rate of 6 d . per week and thereafter at the rate of 2 s . per week.
