THE SPRINGS-ELLESMERE ELECTRIC POWER BOARD

RESOLUTION MAKING SPECIAL RATE

IN pursuance and exercise of the powers vested in it in that behalf by the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926 and of all other powers it thereunto enabling, the Springs-Ellesmere Electric Power Board hereby resolves as follows:

"That, for the purpose of providing security for the repayment, interest, sinking fund, and other charges on a loan of £100,000, to be known as Reticulation Loan No. 12 1956, authorised pursuant to section 3 of the Local Bodies' Loans Amendment Act 1951 to be raised by the Springs-Ellesmere Electric Power Board under the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926 for the purpose of further reticulating the Springs-Ellesmere Electric Power District, the said Board hereby makes and levies a special rate of seven-twentieths ($\frac{7}{20}$) of a penny in the pound upon the rateable value (on the basis of the capital value) of all rateable property of the Springs-Ellesmere Electric Power District, comprising the whole of the Counties of Ellesmere, Springs, and Paparua, parts of the Counties of Selwyn, Halswell, and Malvern, and the town districts of Leeston and Southbridge; and that such rate shall be an annual-recurring rate during the currency of such loan, and be payable yearly on the 1st day of November in each and every year during the currency of such loan, being a period of twenty years, or until the loan is fully paid off."

I hereby certify that the above is a copy of the resolution making a special rate that was duly passed at a special meeting of the Springs-Ellesmere Electric Power Board held at Hornby on 25 October 1956.
