Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 9) 1956

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 9) 1956.
(2) This notice shall come into force on the 15th day of November 1956.
2. Goods of the classes specified in the First Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country other than the countries specified in the Second Schedule hereto, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations. regulations.
