WHEREAS, by Orders in Council made on the 1st day of December 1954 and the 7th day of September 1955, consent was given to the raising in New Zealand by the Springs-Ellesmere Electric Power Board (hereinafter called the said local authority) of a loan of £100,000 to be known as No. 11 Reticulation Loan 1954 (hereinafter called the said loan);

And whereas the said local authority, pending the raising of portion of the said loan amounting to £14,000 (hereinafter called the said sum), is desirous of borrowing the said sum or part thereof by hypothecation or mortgage, pursuant to section 34 of the Local Bodies' Loans Act 1926, of the debentures authorised to be issued in respect of the said loan;

Now, therefore, pursuant to section 7 of the Local Authorities Interest Reduction and Loans Conversion Act 1932-33 and section 8 of the Local Authorities Interest Reduction and Loans Conversion Amendment Act 1933, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby consents to the said local authority, pending the raising of the said sum in accordance with the determinations of the Local Government Loans Board, borrowing the said sum or any part thereof by the hypothecation or mortgage of the said debentures at a rate of interest not exceeding 4½ per cent per annum.
