A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that an easement for the development of water power (substation) is hereby taken over the land described in the Schedule hereto, vesting in Her Majesty the Queen the full and free liberty, right, licence, and authority in perpetuity to lay, construct, place, and maintain a line of underground cables of any size or nature whatsoever in, under, along, and over the land described in the Schedule hereto, and to convey electricity through the said cables, together with the further right for Her Majesty's servants, agents, and workmen to enter upon the said land from time to time, by day and by night, for the purposes of opening up the soil and inspecting, repairing, renewing, operating, testing, and maintaining the said underground cables in good and satisfactory order, such easement to be held appurtenant to the land in Proclamation No. 614 (Canterbury Land Registry).
