A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the Crown land described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby set apart for a public school, and that the Crown land described in the Second Schedule hereto is hereby set apart for a police station; and I also declare that this Proclamation shall take effect on and after the 11th day of February 1957.
