

Price Order No. 1685 (Amendment No. 3 of Price Order No. 1527) (Australian Wheat)

PURSUANT to the Control of Prices Act 1947, the Price Tribunal hereby makes the following amending price order:

1. This order may be cited as Price Order No. 1685, and shall be read together with and deemed part of Price Order No. 1527* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. This order shall come into force on the 8th day of February 1957.
