

Road; thence easterly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Rural Section 3303; thence northerly to and along that boundary and its production to the middle of Buchanans Road; thence north-westerly along the middle of that road to Carmen Road; thence north-easterly along the middle of that road to Yaldhurst Road; thence north-westerly along the middle of that road to Russley Road; thence north-easterly along the middle of Russley Road to the point of commencement.

#### SYDENHAM

All that area bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the middle lines of Moorhouse Avenue and Grove Road and proceeding easterly along the middle of Moorhouse Avenue, northerly along the middle of Fitzgerald Avenue, and south-easterly along the middle of Ferry Road to Ensors Road; thence south-westerly along the middle of Ensors Road and its production to the middle of the Heathcote River; thence up the middle of that river to and up the middle of the Cashmere Stream to a point in line with the western boundary part Lot 3, D.P. 12061; thence northerly generally to and along that boundary, the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 17148, across Cashmere Road, the eastern boundaries of Lots 22 and 15, D.P. 3217, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of Sparks Road; thence north-easterly along the middle of Sparks Road to the middle of the Heathcote River; thence up the middle of that river to the middle of Smartlea Street; thence north-easterly along the middle of Smartlea Street to and north-westerly along the middle of Glynne Crescent to Cobham Street; thence north-easterly along the middle of Cobham Street to Barrington Street; thence northerly generally along the middle of Barrington Street, Howard Street, Collins Street, and the western and northern sides of Church Square, to and along the middle of Grove Road to the point of commencement.

#### LYTTELTON

All that area bounded by a line commencing at Point Gollan at the mouth of the estuary of the Heathcote and Avon Rivers, being a point on the boundary of the Electoral District of Avon, hereinbefore described; thence proceeding westerly generally along that electoral district boundary to and along the southern boundary of the Electoral District of Christchurch Central, hereinbefore described, to the junction of Ferry Road with Ensors Road, being a point on the boundary of the Electoral District of Sydenham, hereinbefore described; thence south-westerly generally along the south-eastern boundary of that electoral district to the eastern side of Worsley Road; thence southerly generally along the eastern side of Worsley Road to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of part Rural Section 37133 (closed road), to and along that boundary, across the Summit Road, to and along the south-western boundary of part Rural Section 452 to the summit of the Port Hills; thence southerly generally along the summit of the Port Hills to and along the eastern boundary of Rural Section 1093 in Block X1, Halswell Survey District, the eastern and south-eastern boundaries of Rural Section 1863, and the south-eastern and south-western boundaries of Rural Section 1901 to Ahuriri Bush Road South; thence to and along the middle of that road to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of Rural Section 1069 in Block X, Halswell Survey District; thence south-westerly generally to and along that boundary to the left bank of the Halswell River, down the left bank of that river to its mouth, and along a right line to a point on the ocean beach, being the outlet of Lake Ellesmere to the sea; thence easterly, northerly, and westerly generally along the sea-coast around Banks Peninsula, crossing the mouths of all harbours and inlets, to Point Gollan, being the point of commencement; together with the County of Chatham Islands and including all wharves and other extensions seaward.

#### SELWYN

All that area bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of Burnside and Russley Roads, being a point on the boundary of the Electoral District of Riccarton, hereinbefore described, and proceeding southerly and easterly generally along that electoral district boundary to and southerly generally along the boundaries of the Electoral Districts of Sydenham and Lyttelton, both hereinbefore described, to the outlet of Lake Ellesmere to the sea; thence south-westerly along the sea coast to a point in line with the middle of Chertsey Boundary Road; thence north-westerly generally to and along the middle of that road, the Main South Road, and Mitcham-Chertsey road to Dromore-Hatfield road; thence south-westerly along the middle of that road to Dromore-Methven road; thence north-westerly along the middle of that road to Mitcham Road; thence north-easterly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Rural Section 27392; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary and the north-eastern boundaries of Rural Sections 27969, 27970, 27985, 28020, 31252, 30505, 30504, and 30509, across Thompsons Road, to and along the north-eastern boundaries of Rural Sections 34170, 30966, and 34169 to Lyndhurst Road; thence south-westerly along the middle of that road and Braernar Road to and along the south-eastern boundary of Rural Section 19532, the eastern and southern boundaries of Rural Section 7967, the south-eastern boundaries of Rural Sections 25911, 19972, 14994, 14001, 17537, 14000, 17535, 13999, 14992, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of the North Branch, Ashburton River; thence north-westerly generally up the middle of that river to its intersection with the production north-easterly of a right line between Trig. Station D in Block XIV, Somers Survey District, and Trig. Station A, Old Man Peak, in Block XI, Somers Survey District; thence south-westerly to and along that right line to Trig. Station D aforesaid; thence northerly along the summit of Mount Somers Range to the source of the South Branch, Swin River; thence down the middle of that branch to its confluence with the North Branch, Swin River; thence due north along a right line to the southern boundary of Run 118A; thence north-westerly generally along the south-western boundaries of the said Run 118A and Run 118 to the middle of Lake Stream; thence northerly along the middle of that stream to the middle of the Rakaia River; thence up the middle of that river to and up the middle of the Loper Stream to its source near Whitcombe Pass; thence north-easterly generally along a right line to Whitcombe Pass and along the summit of the Southern Alps to its junction with the summit of the Snowy Range; thence south-easterly generally along the boundaries of the Electoral Districts of Hurunui and Fendalton, hereinbefore described, to the point of commencement.
