Present: HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928 and the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby authorises the Taranaki Electric Power Board (hereinafter referred to as the licensee), subject to the con-ditions hereinafter set forth, to lay, construct, put up, place, and use electric lines within the areas of supply described in the Schedule hereto; and further, for the purposes of section 76 of the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, subject to the said con-ditions, hereby authorises the licensee to construct electric works within the said areas of supply.

CONDITIONS

IMPLIED CONDITIONS

1. The conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 and the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935 shall be incorporated in and shall form part of this licence, except in so far as the same may be inconsistent with the provisions hereof.

LICENCE SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS

2. The licence hereby conferred is subject to compliance by the licensee with the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, the Radio Interference Regulations 1934, and with all regulations hereafter made in amendment thereof or in substitution therefor respectively.

SYSTEMS OF SUPPLY

3. The systems of supply shall be as described in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f), and (j) of Regulation 21–01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935. The system of supply authorised under paragraph (j) aforesaid shall be a single-conductor earth-return system. The use of the earth-return system of supply shall be subject to such terms and conditions as are from time to time laid down by the General Manager of the State Hydro-electric Department.

DURATION OF LICENCE

4. This licence shall, unless sooner lawfully determined, continue in force until the 16th day of July 1965.
