 District shall be abolished.

 2. That, on the 1st day of April 1957, the areas described
 in the Schedule hereto shall be constituted a united urban fire
 district by the name of the Rotorua United Urban Fire District.

 3. That the number of members to be elected to represent
 the Councils of the Borquigh of Rotorua and the County of
 Rotorua on the Board of the district hereby constituted shall
 be three, who shall be elected in the following manner:

 (a) Two members by resolution of the Rotorua Borough
 - (a) Two members by resolution of the Rotorua Borough Council:
 - (b) One member by resolution of the Rotorua County Council.

4. That the amount to be paid to the Fire Board of the district hereby constituted by the uniting local authorities, pursuant to section 53 of the said Act, shall, as between each of the said uniting local authorities, be in proportion to the capital values of the rateable property in their districts or such part thereof as is included in the said united urban fire district; provided that in the case of that part of the County of Rotorua situated within the said united urban fire district the capital value of each piece of farm land separately valued on the valuation roll shall, for the purposes of the said section 53, be deemed to be the value of all buildings on that land plus the average unimproved value of one-quarter acre of that land.
