Authorising Gerald George Murray, of "Glenmore", Lake Tekapo, Farmer, to Use Water for the Purpose of Generating Electricity

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Public Works Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby grants to Gerald George Murray, of "Glenmore", Lake Tekapo, farmer (hereinafter referred to as the licensee), a licence, subject to the conditions hereinafter set forth, to take and use from the Cass River situated in Run 79, Block I, Tekapo Survey District, in the County of Mackenzie, for the purpose hereinafter set forth, a stream of water not exceeding 4 cubic feet per second at any one time.

CONDITIONS

IMPLIED CONDITIONS

1. The conditions directed to be implied in all licences by the Water Power Regulations 1934 and the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935 shall be incorporated in and shall form part of this licence, except in so far as the same may be inconsistent with the provisions hereof.

LICENCE SUBJECT TO REGULATIONS

2. This licence is issued under the Water Power Regulations 1934, and is subject thereto, and to the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1935, the Radio Interference Regulations 1934, and to all regulations hereafter made in amendment thereof or in substitution therefor respectively.

UTILISATION OF WATER AND LOCATION OF HEADWORKS

3. Water shall be used under this licence solely for the purpose of generating electricity and shall be taken from the said stream at the point in Run 79, Block I, Tekapo Survey District, indicated on the plan marked P.W.D. 92066 deposited in the office of the State Hydro-electric Department at Wellington.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF WORKS

4. The licensee is hereby authorised, subject to the conditions hereof, to construct, maintain, and use the following works for the purpose of this licence, the positions of the said works being indicated on the said plan P.W.D. 92066.

- Headworks consisting of a dam and intake with water race and pipelines leading to the water wheel and powerhouse hereinafter referred to, giving a static head of approximately 23 ft.
- Water wheel and powerhouse with all necessary equipment for generating electricity situated in Run 79, Block I, Tekapo Survey District.
- Tail race leading from the said water wheel to Scotts Creek.

SYSTEM OF SUPPLY

5. The system of supply shall be a direct-current system as described in paragraph (d) of regulation 21-01 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1935.
